Mayor Ferguson called the adjourned meeting of September 11, 2023 back to order.

Order

Mayor Ferguson presented the first order of business from the September 11<sup>th</sup> meeting: Brett Thorne and Cody Hutchinson.

Brett Throne and Cody Hutchinson were present to continue the discussion on allowing them to locate an ice machine on city property. Council agreed to allow them to place the ice machine on the south side of the community building contingent on both parties coming to agreement of the terms of a lease agreement.

Ice Machine

Mayor Ferguson reported Lucas Koch of Koch Construction Specialties has submitted a bid for repairs to the old jail house. The bid is to replace 200 sq. ft. of deteriorated stone, Demo removal, new stone and installation - \$10,000 and repointing of remainder of exterior mortar joints 350 sq. ft. Removal, cleaning and repointing - \$5,250. Ferguson has been unable to reach Mr. Koch to discuss details of the bid. Council tabled the matter until details are gathered.

Old Jail

Mayor Ferguson reported he met with Levi Goodell about cost estimates on the construction of a shop building. He has not received a cost estimate yet.

Old Police

Friend reported he and Scott Hein inspected the Criqui mobile home. Ms. Criqui has made a lot of progress to improve the living conditions in the mobile home. Council agreed with the recommendation to remove the structure from the uninhabitable list.
